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GENERAL INFORMATION

- A. All courses are residential. You are expected to attend the entire programme and all sessions.
- B. The courses begin with Inaugural session at 5.30 p.m. on the first day and conclude with Eucharistic Celebration at 6.45 a.m. on the last day. Departure only after Breakfast.
- C. The accommodation is available only for the duration of the course. Therefore the participants are expected to make their own arrangements in case of early arrivals and late departures.

1. TRAINING FOR SKILLS IN COUNSELLING (TSC-I)

Date: April 15 to 30, 2020

This course is specially designed for priests and consecrated persons who are involved in different ministries like formation, education, social work, healing and so on. Human interactions when they take place in a climate of mutual trust, acceptance, openness, understanding and empathy, become

highly affirmative and therapeutic. As Christian Leaders, all our ministries place us in situations where we are constantly beckoned by the Divine Healer to listen, understand and empathize with people in their brokenness and thus become His 'wounded healers'. This course is meant to sensitize the participants to the 'joys and sorrows' of our sisters and brothers. In order to develop that sensitivity this course will focus on equipping the participants with basic skills in counselling, essential for all those whose mission is to mediate God's compassionate love in any form of ministry. The skills will be learnt through intensive practical sessions.

2. ANTHROPOLOGY OF CHRISTIAN VOCATION AND PEDAGOGY FOR INTEGRAL HUMAN FORMATION

Date: July 05 to 17, 2020

Keeping in mind the purpose of NVSC, to foster integration of psychology and spirituality, this course will focus on the concepts and issues encountered in the study and understanding of human personality in its relation to Vocation to Priesthood and Consecrated Life. Social sciences like anthropology, sociology and psychology offer many insights towards understanding the human person. Not all such insights seem to be reconcilable with the Biblical or Christian understanding of the human person. Therefore, those responsible for the formation of young seminarians and consecrated persons need to be realistically critical, wise and discerning in their choice of insights from various theories of personality. Any theory about the human person that does not acknowledge the intrinsic relationship between nature and grace, the human and the divine, the wholeness and holiness would not fit into pedagogy for integral human formation. The goal of this course is, therefore, to develop a holistic view of

human person which takes into account the latest research in the field of psychology and spirituality.

3. THERAPEUTIC JOURNEY TO WHOLENESS (TJW)

Date: September 20 to October 11, 2020

This course is specially designed for priests and consecrated persons. It is aimed to deepen their understanding of their own existing beliefs, attitudes, values, needs, roles, shadows, and ego defenses and providing an opportunity to enhance their self-understanding and personal growth so that they will become authentic, functional, effective and empowered persons. Participants are helped to get in touch with their emotional woundedness and how it affects their lives of commitment as priests and consecrated persons. Group therapy and other therapeutic healing techniques will enable participants to resolve some of their deep seated emotional conflicts and work towards a psycho spiritual integration of their personalities.

Course Contents:

- Self- Awareness,
- Inner Child,
- Management of Emotions,
- Group Therapy.

Total Course Contribution: INR, 14,500/-

4. TRAINING FOR SKILLS IN COUNSELLING (TSC-II)

Date: October 18 to November 08, 2020.

This course is specially designed for priests and consecrated persons who are involved in different ministries like formation, education, social work, healing and so on. Human interactions when they take place in a climate of mutual trust, acceptance, openness, understanding and empathy, become

highly affirmative and therapeutic. 5. DIPLOMA IN COUNSELLING PSYCHOLOGY & RELIGIOUS FORMATION

Date: June 18, 2020 – March 21, 2021

The Diploma programme is designed specifically for Priests and Religious those in the fields of Formation and Counselling: Pastors, Spiritual Directors, Novice Masters/Mistresses, School Counsellors, and those who engage in family and health ministries, to enhance their confidence and skills. The focus of the programme is on helping people to integrate the human, spiritual, theological and social facets of their experience with the current realities facing Priestly and Consecrated Life.

The inputs include topics like Current Trends in Theology of Religious/Priestly life, Biblical Spirituality, Discernment of Spirits, Spiritual Direction in Priestly/Religious Formation, Eco-Spirituality and Study of Human Personality, Anthropology of Christian Vocation and Formation,

Self-Awareness for Transformation, Personality Theories, Psycho-sexual Integration for Celibate Life, Developmental Psychology, Personality Disorders, Psychopathology, Befriending the Inner Child, Neuro Linguistic Programming (NLP), Assessment of Personality, Awareness Meditative Relaxation (AMR), Rational Emotive Behavioural Therapy (REBT) etc. Counselling Skills (both Theory and Practice) are taught with a specific reference to human and spiritual growth of participants. The Trainees are introduced to the tools for interviewing and assessing candidates to priesthood and religious life. A great deal of emphasis is placed on human growth where participants are taken through personal growth-workshops and compulsory individual Counselling and Group Therapy experience.

The last date for submitting duly filled application form is April 20, 2020. Application Form is available on the Website.

If you are seeking admission, you are required to be present at NVSC from **03rd 4 p.m. to 06th noon, May, 2020** for the admission process.
