- A. All courses are residential. You are expected to attend the entire programme and all sessions.
- B. Each day is fully scheduled with classes or activities.

1. THERAPEUTIC JOURNEY TO WHOLENESS (TJW)

Date: April 3rd to 25th, 2025 (3 weeks)

This course is specially designed for priests and consecrated persons. It is aimed to deepen the understanding of their own beliefs, attitudes, values, needs, shadows, and ego defenses and providing an opportunity to enhance their self-understanding and personal growth to become authentic, effective and empowered persons. Group therapy and other therapeutic healing techniques will enable participants to work towards a psycho-spiritual integration of their personalities.

2. TRAINING FOR SKILLS IN COUNSELLING (TSC)

Date: November 2nd to November 23rd, 2025 (3 weeks)

This course is designed for persons who are involved in different ministries like formation, spiritual direction, education, social work, health ministry, and so on. Human interactions when they take place in a climate of mutual trust, acceptance, openness, understanding, and empathy, become highly affirmative and therapeutic. This course will focus on equipping the participants with basic skills in counselling taught through intensive practical sessions.

3. DIPLOMA IN COUNSELLING PSYCHOLOGY & INTEGRAL FORMATION

**Date: June 18, 2025 to March 26, 2026
(Age Group 30 to 50)**

The Diploma programme is designed specifically for those in the fields of formation and counselling: Rectors, Novice Directors, Formation Personnel, Spiritual Directors, School Counsellors, and those who engage in family, social and health ministries, and community services to enhance their confidence and guidance skills. The focus of the programme is helping people to become change agents bringing healing to individuals and whole of creation.

The inputs include topics like Study of Human Personality, Developmental Psychology, Mental Health in the Digital Age, Assessment of Personality, Anthropology of Christian Vocation and Formation, Discernment, Spiritual Direction, Eco-Spirituality, Self-Awareness, Personality Theories, Psycho-sexual Integration, Counselling Skills to Treat Trauma and Abuse, Personality Disorders, Psychopathology, Inner Child Healing, Awareness Meditative Relaxation (AMR), etc. Counselling Skills (Theory and

Supervised Practicum) are taught with a specific reference to human and spiritual growth of participants. The Trainees are introduced to the tools for interviewing and assessing candidates to priesthood and consecrated life. A great deal of emphasis is placed on human growth where participants are facilitated through personal growth workshops and compulsory regular Individual Counselling and Group Therapy experience.

Total Course Contribution: INR 1,35,000/- (Subsidized).
