1. THERAPEUTIC JOURNEY TO WHOLENESS (TJW)

April 8th to 28th, 2026 (3 weeks)

This course is specially designed for priests and consecrated persons towards personal growth and inner healing. It is aimed to deepen the understanding of their own beliefs, attitudes, values, needs, shadows, and ego defenses and providing an opportunity to enhance their self-understanding and personal growth to become authentic and effective persons in their ministry and service.

Course Contents: Self-Awareness, Management of Emotions and Group Therapy.

2. BASIC SKILLS FOR VOCATION PROMOTION AND FORMATION (BSVF)

September 28th to November 22, 2026 (8 weeks)

(Limited Number)

This course is designed for persons who are involved in different ministries/services working among young people such as vocation promotion, formation, spiritual

direction, youth development, education, social work, health ministry, and so on. Human interactions when they take place in a climate of mutual trust, acceptance, openness, understanding, and empathy, become highly affirmative and therapeutic. This course will focus on equipping the participants with basic skills in understanding and counselling young people taught through lectures and practical sessions.

3. DIPLOMA IN COUNSELLING PSYCHOLOGY & INTEGRAL FORMATION

Date: June 17, 2026 – March 25, 2027
(Age Group 30 to 55)

The Diploma programme is designed specifically for those in the fields of formation and counselling: Rectors, Novice Directors, Formation Personnel, Spiritual Directors, School Counsellors, and those who engage in family, social and health ministries, and community services to enhance their confidence and guidance skills. The focus of the programme is helping people to become change agents bringing healing to individuals and whole of creation.

The inputs include topics such as Developmental Psychology, Mental Health in the Digital Age, Assessment of Personality, Anthropology of Christian Vocation and Formation, Discernment and Decision Making, Spiritual Direction, Eco-Spirituality, Self-Awareness, Personality Theories, Counselling Skills to Treat Trauma and Abuse, Personality Disorders, Psychopathology, Awareness Meditative Relaxation (AMR), etc. Counselling Skills (Theory and Supervised Practicum) are taught with a specific reference to human and spiritual growth of participants. The Trainees are introduced to the tools for interviewing and assessing candidates to priesthood and consecrated life. The participants are taken through

personal growth workshops and compulsory regular Individual Counselling and Group Therapy experience.
